Winter Parking Restrictions

From **December 1st until April 1st**, there is **NO PARKING** on any Village Street between the hours of 2:00am and 7:00am. **This restriction is in effect regardless of the weather or temperature.** Be sure to let your late night/overnight guests know about the parking restrictions. Violators are subject to a \$100 citation. If the citation is paid within 7 days, the fine is reduced to \$25. If an emergency circumstance prevents you from moving a vehicle, please call the Sheboygan County Sheriff Department at 920-459-3111.

2025 Tax Collection

The 2025 Property Tax bills will have a new look this year. Instead of the highly customized bill you received in the past, you will now receive an 8 ½ X 11 sheet with a tear off stub at the very top. Please return the stub along with your payment to ensure your payment is applied correctly. If you have any questions, please contact us at 920-234-0304, and we will be happy to assist you.

First installment tax payments are due Jan. 31, 2026. For accounting reasons, we do not accept combined payments for taxes, dog licenses and sewer payments. **They must be paid separately.**

Several options are available for making your tax payment:

- In-person: Stop at the Village Hall Mondays through Thursdays from 8:00am-4:00pm, or Fridays from 8:00am-12:00pm. You will receive a receipt at the time of your payment. We will **not accept cash** payments at the Village Hall. All cash payments will need to be made at Cleveland State Bank.
- 2nd option: Pay your taxes at Cleveland State Bank, Howards Grove or Elkhart Lake branches. Make your payment during regular bank hours.
- After Hours: Drop your payment in our secure “Envelope Depository” slot (to the left of the Village Hall front door). If you would like a receipt, include a self-addressed, stamped envelope.
- By Mail: Send your payment to Village of Howards Grove, 913 S. Wisconsin Drive, Howards Grove, WI 53083. If you would like a receipt, include a self-addressed, stamped envelope.
- Bill Pay: If you are sending us a check from your bank's Bill Pay, please be sure to include all parcel numbers or bill numbers in the memo so payments are processed correctly.
- By Credit Card: Go to www.howardsgrovewi.gov and click on “Online Payments”. Click the “Click to Pay Now” button and enter PLC #7444, then complete the requested information. The deadline for online payments is January 31st, 2026. There is a fee for this service.

As in past years, the **second installment payments are due by July 31st, 2026, and must be made payable to the Sheboygan County Treasurer's Office**, at the Administration Building, 508 New York Avenue, Sheboygan. Please do not send your second installment checks to the Village Clerk's office.

The local positions to be filled at the April election are Village Trustees - 3, (Incumbents are Taylor Horness, Connie Meyer and Mike Winter). Nomination papers are available starting December 1st, 2025, and are due by 5:00p.m. on January 5th, 2026.

Here you will find links on everything that relates to voting in Wisconsin, from changes of name or address to new voter information to requesting an absentee ballot!

Dog Licenses

All dog licenses **expire December 31st, 2025**, regardless of when they were issued. New 2026 licenses will be available by mid-December. **The fee is \$8 for spayed/neutered dogs and \$15 for un-spayed/neutered dogs.** Remember that a current rabies certificate is required to obtain a license. **A late fee of \$20** per dog is charged if dogs are not licensed by **April 1st, 2026**. Failure to obtain a required license is subject to a \$100 citation. If you no longer have a dog that was previously licensed, let the Clerk's office at Village Hall know so that our records can be updated. In addition, if you have recently moved into the Village, the Clerk's office needs rabies information, even if the dog was licensed elsewhere in Wisconsin. Please note the maximum number of dogs and/or cats that a resident may keep at any one property is four (4).

Christmas Tree Disposal

The Village will recycle non-artificial holiday trees, typically every Tuesday in January. To place your tree for recycling, please remove all decorations from the tree. The Village will be chipping the trees, so all tinsel, lights and decorations **MUST** be removed. Also, do not wrap the tree in plastic. Place your tree curbside after removing all decorations. If you use plastic wrap to help you remove the tree from your home, please remove it before placing it curbside. Artificial trees or live trees with root balls will not be accepted for recycling.

2026 Park Shelter Rentals

Shelters are available at both Memorial Park and Riverside Park. Reservations are accepted for dates from May 24th to October 1st (may open later or close earlier due to weather). The fee is \$150 for Village residents and \$200 for Non-Residents. **A refundable deposit of \$65 is included in the rental fee and will be returned via a mailed check upon satisfaction of the rental agreement.** Rental agreements are available on our website or by visiting Village Hall.

Jan. 1, 2026: Parks may be reserved online only beginning at midnight on January 1st, 2026, or at 8:00am on January 2nd at Village Hall. Shelters are available on a first-come, first-served basis. No reservations will be made without payment.

The Old Middle School

After significant work with asbestos abatement, the demolition of the old middle school is finally underway. While the land and building have been listed for sale for quite some time, we have not received any viable offers to purchase the land and/or the building. Once the building is removed and the land is converted to "green space", the School Board will restart the effort to sell the land for future development. Please know, this land is zoned by the Village of Howards Grove as residential. Therefore, without any zoning changes by the Village, this land will remain residential. A handful of residents have asked about the plan for the land and have mentioned apartment buildings or low income housing. Please know, that has not been an option considered by the School Board or the Village Board. The preliminary discussions have been to have a developer design single family homes to bring families into the school district to raise our enrollment and help the tax base in the Village of Howards Grove with additional properties on the tax roll.

Maintenance Shed

Another topic that has come to our attention is the placement of the new maintenance shed. Please know that the old maintenance shed will be demolished and sold as part of the land described above. The district is committed to ensuring the new maintenance shed is properly maintained and will include hearty landscaping and design to keep our site looking nice.
