Work on the baseball field is complete, and the softball outfield has been hydro-seeded.


The courtyard is taking shape as well, with concrete poured, landscaping installed, and lighting now in place.

Inside, first floor concrete grinding and polishing are underway in Area E, while the gym is seeing the installation of its hardwood floor and final finishes. Final finishes and touch-ups are taking place in the administration offices, while other interior areas are seeing continued progress on finishes and equipment installation.




WHAT'S NEXT
