Brothers take ownership of Log Cabin Inn



Albanian business partners and brothers Ardy and Benny Gashi came to America as teens from North Macedonia in January 2014 with a dream to own a restaurant of their own.

As of Sept. 1st, they have become the new owners of the Log Cabin Inn in Howards Grove. Since coming to America, Ardy and Benny have been working in the restaurant industry at various locations in the Sheboygan area before owning their first restaurant, the Blue Ox in Monroe.

“We have been doing really well there” Ardi said in an interview, “and we wanted to expand and own another restaurant.”

After being closed for a short period of time for a few kitchen renovations, the Log Cabin Inn reopened for business Sept. 1st. According to Ardy, they received great feedback from their customers on the Log Cabin Inn Facebook page and on Google reviews with the service and food selections since they reopened.



BUILDING PERMITS

Applications for building or remodeling permits can be obtained at the Village Hall during regular office hours or online at www.howardsgrove.wi.gov. Go to the Services tab, then “Building Inspection” in the drop-down menu. You may complete the application in the Clerk/Treasurer’s office; however, some permits may not be immediately issued and will be reviewed by the Building Inspector. The appropriate fees, possible inspections, and any additional documents required will be determined by the Building Inspectors.

Please note, you may not begin construction until the application is approved by the Building Inspector, allow ample time before the start date of your project.





BUILDING PROJECTS PROGRESS REPORT

August 2024 Update


WHERE WE'VE BEEN

The busy summer has continued through June and July, and the construction team is making great headway.

Inside the existing high school, mechanical, electrical, and plumbing (MEP) contractors have completed their overhead work in the athletic hallway, and the ceiling is set to be replaced in the coming weeks to prepare for school being back in session.

Outside, all the concrete is poured for the new high school office foundation, and the ironworkers are wrapping up steel erection.

The tennis courts have been paved, and crews are now waiting for the 30-day cure time before final surfacing can begin.



WHERE WE ARE

Steel erection is nearing completion at the high school addition and is fully underway at the middle school.

Inside the building, renovation work in the Library Media Center (LMC)

continues and is on track to finish in early August, so students can enjoy the renovated space this upcoming school year.

Window replacements have also begun and are expected to wrap up the third week of July.




WHAT'S NEXT

With the school year fast approaching, contractors are making their final pushes to complete all interior work this summer.

This includes the addition of multiple Variable Air Volume (VAV) systems, water lines for the middle school addition, and fire protection lines for the high school addition.

At the tennis court, fencing will soon be installed, and the court will be surfaced shortly thereafter to prepare for competition this fall. The track will also be stripped and resurfaced before the first football game of the season.

At the middle school addition, concrete will continue to be poured daily, and steel erection will proceed as we plan for building envelope work to begin. Exciting times ahead!
